

## ConcealBrowse Release Notes v0.11.5

This document goes over information regarding our new release updates and bug fixes for ConcealBrowse v0.11.5. **Please see below for additional information!**

### Bug Fixes

**Fixed** – After deploying to your end-users using the MSI, some users report that they are being asked to authenticate creating a disruption in their web browsing experience. We have addressed this issue so that ConcealBrowse will try to authenticate again to ensure a successful deployment across all supported browsers.

**Fixed** – Redirect error when using Cisco Umbrella. For customers that make use of the Cisco Umbrella integration, the redirect not working error has been resolved.

**Fixed** – Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) error that prevents interaction with web pages using outdated layering methods.

### What's new in ConcealBrowse?

**Fail open to preserve user experience.** If the end user encounters any errors with the operation of ConcealBrowse, the application will fail open allowing them to browse the web normally. **If this happens, the end user will receive a one-time alert that they are not protected by ConcealBrowse and that they should contact their administrator.** Future enhancements will give administrators the capability to control the ability to fail open.

**New status codes.** Don't worry if you are no longer seeing the green ON or red OFF indicators on the ConcealBrowse extension icon. **The icon (located next to your address bar) will now display different colors to indicate status codes with the operation of the extension.**

**Blue** - Logged in and protection is active.



**Gray** - Not logged in, protection is not active.



**Red Overlay** - Authentication error.



**Authentication error messaging.** When a user encounters the authentication error marked by the red overlay, they can click on the icon to see the error. **This is used for troubleshooting.**
